Lajos Ligeti (1902–1987) is one of the greatest and most important figures in the history of Oriental studies in Hungary. His activity covered various fields of Oriental studies (beyond Mongolian studies, mostly turkology, Tibetan studies and sinology), and his significant achievements in the research of early contacts and relations of the Hungarian language are also invaluable. He is the founder of the Department of Mongolian and Inner Asian studies, and his educational and organizing activity made possible the creation of various institutions, initiatives, journals and book series, which enhanced the reputation of Hungarian Oriental studies on international level. The foundation of Acta Orientalia Academiae Scientiarum Hungaricae journal and the Oriental Collection of the Library and Information Center of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences belong to these invaluable achievements.

The conference is dedicated to Lajos Ligeti's memory and legacy. The presentations of Hungarian and international scholars, renowned researchers, his pupils and carriers of his academic legacy cover topics on Ligeti's activity and achievements, brief introduction to his unpublished materials opened recently, and other topics related to his researches.
